

# Pinot Noir Précoce, 2022

Planted by twin sisters, Mel & Zoë, in Spring 2022, this variety thrives on the red sandy soil of our 5 acre Shropshire vineyard.

After an excellent summer, we were able to really ripen a portion of our Pinot Noir Précoce grapes, resulting in this balanced red wine. The black cherry fruit character is complemented by some structured oak and subtle silky tannins. Classically English and terribly moreish!

## Vintage report

2022 gave us plenty of options in the vineyard, the hot dry weather really paved the way for us to make a Red wine, something we know that we won't be able to make every year!

We left a small portion of our Précoce grapes a further 7 days on the vine to help increase the sugar levels and gain a deeper intensity of flavour.
