

# Pinot Noir Précoce, 2022

75 cl / 12% Vol

*Pink*

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This variety thrives on our red sandy soils, and makes up 27% of our 5 acre vineyard. Planted by twin sisters, Mel & Zoë in Spring 2020.

Our Pinot Noir Précoce grapes (an early ripening relative of Pinot Noir) were crush destemmed and spent 2 hours on skins to extract the beautiful pink colour. The ideal summer sipper, this wine is full of lush strawberry and cherry notes, rounded off with an herbaceous hint.

## *Vintage report*

*2022 saw us craft our very first harvest from our vineyard. The weather was superb all year, with no frost damage in the late Spring, followed by good flowering weather and one of the hottest summers on record to ripen it all.*

*Careful canopy management such as shoot thinning, and leaf removal allowed these small bunches to ripen well on the vine, harvested in late September.*
